## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- Kickball teams will be co-ed and include at least 3 female players. Teams must have at least 10 players with a maximum of 12 players. We will play with 10 on the field. The infield will consist of 6 players and outfield will consist of 4 players.
- Check-in Sunday, September 11 at 9:30am at the Loren Hawks Field. A brief 15-minute meeting will start 9:45am, to go over rules and expectations.
- 3. Players should be 13 years of age and up. All Players will have to fill out a waiver when checking in. All players should be included in the rosters.
- 4. Cannot steal bases, players must remain on base until the kicker makes contact.
- 5. The ball can be thrown at any player and must hit shoulder and below. The runner will be called safe if it hits their head unless they are sliding/ducking the ball. If a player is hit in the head, they get the base they are running to. (If a runner ducks to avoid throw and it hits them in the head it will be an out.)
- 6. On an overthrow the runner may advance at their own risk. They are allowed to run more than one base if they want.
- 7. A game will include 5 full innings or 45 minutes long, which ever comes first.
- 8. OT innings will be played if the game ends in a tie. Maximum of 2 OT innings. If still in a tie, the winner will be decided by flipping a coin. Play time will be 45 minutes unless the game ends in a tie.
- 9. Mercy guideline: A game will be considered final if one team leads by 15 or more runs after 3 complete innings. 4.5 if the home team leads.
- 10. Bunting is not allowed. (Bunting is defined as a kicked ball that does not cross the 1st-3rd diagonal line or reach a fielder (whichever comes first) before the kicker crosses the hash mark halfway down the first baseline. And a kicked ball that comes to a complete stop on its own before reaching the 1st-3rd diagonal line will be considered a bunt.)
- 11.4 foul balls will be considered an out.

- 12. Closed toe athletic shoes are required. Metal cleats are NOT allowed.
- 13. All team members must be on the team roster and signed the waiver prior to the start of the tournament.
- 14. The officiating of each game will be done by the teams who have entered. The first teams to officiate will be chosen at random from teams who are not playing. After the first games the losing team(s) will officiate the game(s) after their loss.
- 15.Pitching: Each team will pitch to their own team member. Pitchers must pitch from the pitching mound and cannot interfere with any plays during the game. Just remember, this is slow-pitch kickball. No bouncing pitches.
- 16. Tournament size will determine if the tournament will be a single or double elimination type. That will be announce before the tournament starts.
